E-BIKE, E-SCOOTER & E-SKATEBOARD POLICY:

All E-bikes, E-scooters and E-skateboards are required to have a **REGISTRATION STICKER** and be **PARKED & LOCKED** in one of the approved bike rack areas on campus. PARKING PERMITS: Please follow the instructions on the PHS website prior to requesting a permit, click [HERE](#) for all information. Students are only allowed to park in the student parking lot (Bulldog lot off Merit). Parking in any other lot may result in a warning notice or a wheel lock boot.

ATTENTION BULLDOG DRIVERS! Please be respectful when parking off campus. Consequences for not following the community rules can result in towing and potential citations from IPD. Please be respectful to the Irvine community.

ATTENDANCE (949) 936-8201: Early dismissals require a parent/guardian signature or note, calling the office to release your student is not allowed. Please either sign the student out from the Attendance office or for a quicker release, the student may bring in a note and turn it in to the Attendance office in the morning. Notes **MUST** include: student's name, short ID#, date, time of dismissal, reason for absence and parent signature. To help minimize interruptions to the classrooms, please plan appointments during break, lunch or during a free period. **For student drivers; a note from parent is required to leave campus early.**

ON-CAMPUS FOOD DELIVERY: The Front Office does **NOT** accept food deliveries for students. PHS is a closed campus, delivery people are not allowed to deliver on campus to classrooms or any campus office or space. Students should request delivery to a specific **PHS PARKING LOT** and only during break or lunch. Please be specific with delivery location on order instructions.

ITEM DROP OFF: The Front Office does **NOT** accept drop offs of homework, instruments, electronics, food, projects or any other item that may be forgotten. Students can meet you at the front office during break, lunch or open period to hand them their forgotten item.
