PARKING PERMITS: Please follow the instructions on the PHS website prior to requesting a permit, click **HERE** for all information. Students are only allowed to park in the student parking lot (Bulldog lot off Merit). Parking in any other lot may result in a warning notice or a wheel lock boot. Permits will be distributed during lunch in the Bulldog parking lot, you must have all paperwork and the vehicle on campus.

<u>ATTENDANCE (949) 936-8201</u>: Early dismissals require a parent/ legal guardian signature or note, calling the office to release your student is not allowed. Please either sign the student out from the Attendance office or for a quicker release, the student may bring in a note and turn it in to the Attendance office in the morning. Notes **MUST** include: student's name, short ID#, date, time of dismissal, reason for absence and parent/legal guardian's signature. To help minimize interruptions to the classrooms, please plan appointments during break, lunch or during a free period. For student drivers; a note from parent/legal guardian is required to leave campus early.

ON-CAMPUS FOOD DELIVERY: The Front Office does **NOT** accept food deliveries for students. PHS is a closed campus, delivery people are not allowed to deliver on campus to classrooms or any campus office or space. Students should request delivery to a specific **PHS PARKING LOT** and only during break or lunch. Please be specific with delivery location on order instructions.
