IMPORTANT PARKING ENFORCEMENT NOTICE: Regular parking enforcement will be occurring across all campus parking lots and structures. E-VEHICLE PARKING PERMITS: E-vehicles are required to have a **REGISTRATION STICKER** and be **PARKED & LOCKED** at the Cadence/Chinon bike rack area. **Stickers are distributed MONDAY ONLY after 7th & 8th periods at the NEW bike racks.** Click **HERE** for all information.

CAR PARKING PERMITS: Click **HERE** for all parking permit information. **Permits are distributed during lunch on MONDAY ONLY in the Bulldog parking lot**, you must have all paperwork and the vehicle on campus, **DO NOT PARK ON CAMPUS WITHOUT A PERMIT!**

ITEM DROP OFF: The Front Office does **NOT** accept drop-offs of homework, instruments, electronics, food, projects or any other item that may be forgotten.

LOST & FOUND: If you have a lost item, Lost & Found is located at the front office.

ATTENDANCE (949) 936-8201: **Early dismissals require a parent/ legal guardian signature or note, calling the office to release your student is not allowed.** Please either sign the student out from the Attendance office or for a quicker release, the student may bring in a note and turn it in to the Attendance office in the morning. **Notes MUST include:** student's name, short ID#, date, time of dismissal, reason for absence and parent/legal guardian's signature.
