Students should request delivery to a specific **PHS PARKING LOT** and only during break or lunch.

<u>ITEM DROP OFF:</u> The Front Office does **NOT** accept drop offs of homework, instruments, electronics, food, projects or any other item that may be forgotten. Students can meet you at the front office during break,

ATTENDANCE (949) 936-8201: Early dismissals require a parent/legal guardian signature or note, calling the office to release your student is not allowed. Notes MUST include: student's name, short ID#, date, time of dismissal, reason for absence and parent/legal guardian's signature.
