## Reminders

### Use 1 application to apply to any of the 23 campuses

• \$70 fee per campus, but students who qualify for fee waivers due to family income can apply to up to 4 UC's for free

## No need to submit official transcripts or AP exam scores when applying

• You must self-report your grades and AP scores, and you will be required to submit your final transcript and AP scores once you commit to the school





### Reminders

#### Admissions criteria

• High School Diploma or equivalent or be 18 years of age or older. There is no application fee.

Complete the admissions steps listed on the community college websites

### Apply by priority registration deadline

• Priority registration allows students to enroll in courses early before classes become full

## **Requesting Letters of Recommendation**

In order to request letters of recommendation, you will first need to match your Common App Account with Naviance



- Log onto Naviance
- Click on Colleges > Colleges I'm Applying To
- Click the "Match Accounts" button
- Log on to your Common App account to complete the matching process

## Requesting a Teacher Recommendation

### Request as soon as 1st day of school (August 24)

- Request a letter of recommendation from your teacher (either in-person or email)
- Complete the letter of recommendation Google Form (see below to create a copy) or other method that the teacher requests

Requesting a Counselor Recommendation

### Window to request a counselor letter: September 2-30

- Finalize your college list by adding them to "Colleges I'm Applying To" and include which deadlines you plan to meet on Naviance
- Update your resume with your activities, awards, and accomplishments on Naviance
- Complete your "PHS Letter of Recommendation Survey" on Naviance
- Make your letter of rec request with Counseling Clerk Ms. Phoebe in the Counseling Office

# **Requesting Transcripts**

Please note that you will NOT need to request transcripts when applying to UC/CSU schools (send final transcript if you have committed to a UC/CSU schoool) or a college you are applying to via Naviance (your counselor will be submitting your transcript on your behalf).
