- 1. **PRINTING** is available in the Learning Commons on designated laptops at the Circulation Desk before school, during break, or after school. There is a 50 page limit per learner per month. Black and white only. What's printed at one break will not be ready for pick up until the next break. All completed print jobs are available from the sorter located by the entrance door to the Learning Commons.
- 2. The **CHARGING LOCKER** located in the Learning Commons allows learners to securely charge their device during the school day. Learners are expected to bring their laptops to school every day fully charged, but if their device needs additional charging the lockers are available. <u>Click here</u> to learn more.
- 3. The PROQUEST database is available to all PHS learners for research and school projects. Unlike information found by a general search on the Internet, all database resources are reviewed by an editor for accuracy and bias.
