LEARNING COMMONS: Textbooks - Check with your learner to make sure they have all required textbooks for their classes. If they have dropped a class for which they received a book, please have them return it as soon as possible. Chromebook Insurance - If you have checked out a school-issued Chromebook, you may be interested in insurance to cover accidental damage or loss for the 2019-20 school year. To purchase this insurance go to the website and complete the Worth Group insurance [form](#) linked here. This optional insurance is \$22.

When completing the insurance form, you will need to select the model of your Chromebook from a drop down menu. The menu has a choice of three different models listed. To determine which model you have, look at the cover. The HP model is clearly labeled with a big HP logo. The Dell 3180 and 3120 models look very similar. The Dell 3180 model is labeled on the back of the device under the serial number with a 3180. If you find no model number there, you have a Dell 3120.
