E-BIKE, E-SCOOTER & E-SKATEBOARD POLICY:

- PHS students are allowed to park and lock their **PHS REGISTERED** E-bike, E-scooter and/or E-skateboard in one of the approved bike rack areas on campus.
- Starting on **March 27th, 2023**, all E-bikes, E-scooters and E-skateboards must have a registration sticker and be parked in an authorized location on campus.
- Any student who attended one of the safety meetings but has not received a registration sticker: Campus security will be issuing them to students with completed registration forms during lunch at the bike racks near the theater parking lot.
- Make-up safety meetings are TBD for students who were not able to attend a safety meeting.
- Students who do not follow policy will be subject to PHS progressive discipline policy. Possible consequences include but are not limited to: warning, detention, Saturday School, and/or suspension.
