## I. EDL Update

## a. <u>Survey Communication</u>

- i. The survey reported that there are some Social Emotional Learning (SEL) challenges with students. Counselors are working on these learners.
- ii. Some learners are totally fine with EDL with no real changes in their lives!
- iii. If we have to start with EDLs in the fall, then we will try to be intentional toward encouraging learners to seek help and assistance as needed

#### II. Annual Survey

- a. There are no key findings from the Hanover survey yet because we don't have the survey back yet. We should receive results this summer
- b. Summary with main points draft
  - i. There is not longitudinal data on all points, but there is enough to make some inferences.
  - ii. The executive survey shows some trends from year to year, some possible areas of strength, and potential action steps that can be incorporated into an annual plan.
  - iii. All in attendance went through the linked survey results.
    - 1. Important to note that 100% of teachers accept late work!
    - 2. There was a comment that learners may rate liking school more once they return to campus.
    - 3. A book titled <u>Fewer Things, Better</u> will be the staff read for next year.

  - iv. We are also anticipating an Engineering and BITA (Building Industrial Technology Academy) class next year, funding permitting
